Our training program will provide the resident with opportunities to learn and acquire the necessary tools to effectively manage a community pharmacy service. In addition, the resident will have the opportunity to work with well-qualified ambulatory care pharmacists to help further develop the resident's clinical, teaching, and research skills. The primary training sites for the residency are Golden Gate Pharmacy located in San Rafael and Touro University located in Vallejo.

Curriculum

The program will be tailored to meet the resident's needs and career goals. The resident will be given opportunities to develop skills in the following areas:

- Medication Therapy Management (MTM)
- Design, Implement, and Augment Pharmacy Services
- Public Health & Wellness Promotion
- Immunization & Disease Prevention Programs
- Promote Pharmacy Services at a Safety Net Clinic
- Administrative & Management Skills
- Innovative Veterinary & Traditional Compounding Product Development

Additional longitudinal experiences include: completing the full teaching program, participating in research seminars, and precepting at the Student Run Health clinic. The resident will also be required to staff at Golden Gate Pharmacy every other Saturday throughout the year.

This community pharmacy residency is a one-year postgraduate training program. It is designed for individuals who seek opportunities to gain experiences in chronic disease management and prevention, psychiatric and consulting pharmacy, and veterinary and traditional compounding.

Qualifications

The applicant must have a Doctorate of Pharmacy (PharmD) degree from an ACPE (American Council of Pharmaceutical Education) accredited pharmacy school, have U.S. citizenship or a Green Card, and be eligible to sit for California pharmacist licensure examinations.

Application

Applications are due **January 9th, 2017**. Applicant(s) should be ready to sit for the board exams on or before July 31st, 2017. Apply online through the PhORCAS system. Applications will not be accepted via mail. Please submit a letter of intent, pharmacy school transcript, curriculum vitae, and 3 letters of recommendation.
