The Touro University California College of Pharmacy is a four-year, accredited Doctor of Pharmacy school that prepares students for a clinically-oriented, contemporary pharmacy practice. A unique feature of the program is a two-year pharmacy practice or clerkship experience. This enhanced exposure to patients is designed to create a more clinically mature graduate who will be fully prepared to enter pharmacy practice or pursue post-graduate pharmacy residencies, fellowships or graduate work.



The college is located on historic Mare Island on the San Francisco Bay, one hour by car and 40 minutes by ferry from San Francisco.

The 44-acre campus, shaded by eucalyptus trees and surrounded by San Pablo Bay, is a rare and tranquil site for this growing academic center.

The Touro University California College of Pharmacy supports 11 pharmacy residencies and one fellowship situated at various major health care institutions in the Bay Area and in San Diego. All of our residency and fellowship programs aim to train and prepare future pharmacist practitioners to be leaders in their fields of interest.
