### Qualifications

The applicant must have a Doctorate of Pharmacy (PharmD) degree from an ACPE accredited pharmacy school (or in process of pursuing accreditation) or a Foreign Pharmacy Graduate Equivalency Certificate (FPGEC) from National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP). Applicants must also have U.S. citizenship or Green card and be eligible to sit for examination for CA pharmacist licensure.

### Application

Deadline for applications is **January 4th, 2019**. Applicant(s) should be ready to sit for the board exams on or before July 31, 2019. Apply online through the PhORCAS system using **National Matching Service Code 215113**. Please submit a letter of intent, pharmacy school transcript, curriculum vitae and 3 letters of recommendation (standardized reference form) as part of the PhORCAS application.
