Eligibility criteria

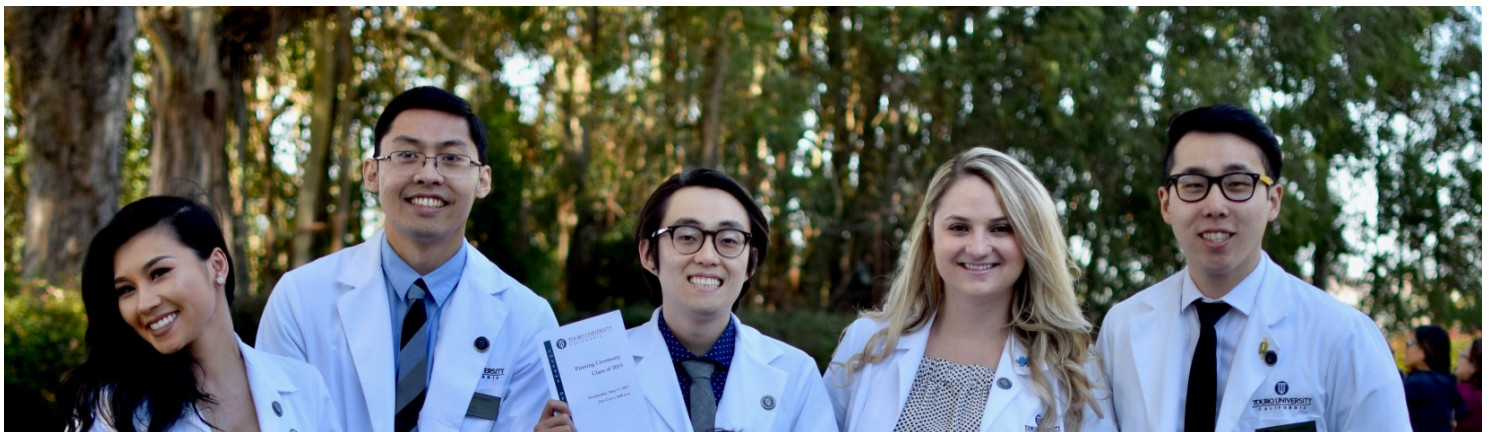
- Good academic standing (minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale)
- Bi/multi-lingual
- Intern or volunteer their time with an organization that supports underserved populations

Review criteria

- Scholastic achievement
- Commitment to serving underserved populations
- Fluent speaking at least one language in addition to English
- Preference for interest in community pharmacy practice upon graduation, or current or previous experience in community practice

Submit for review

- Documentation of a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (Unofficial transcript from the TCWeb is acceptable)
- Current resume or CV demonstrating intern or volunteer time to an organization that supports underserved populations
- Current resume or CV documenting language(s) other than English spoken fluently
- One-page essay describing your language skills and commitment to underserved populations, and how these experiences will help you in your future career as a pharmacist. The essay must be single-spaced, Time New Roman font size 12, 1" margins.
