Eligibility checklist

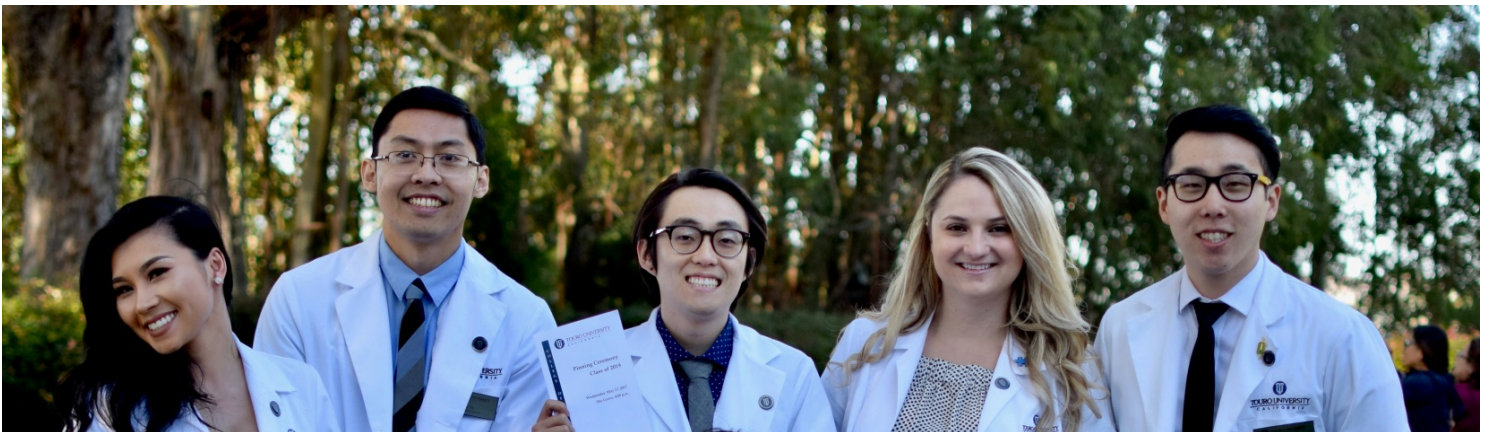
- I am in good academic standing (minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale)
- I am bi/multi-lingual
- I have interned or volunteered my time with an organization that supports underserved populations

Review criteria

- Academic achievement
- Commitment to serving underserved populations
- Essay writing, including your commitment to underserved populations and how it will help in your future career as pharmacist

Submit for review

- Documentation of a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Unofficial transcript is acceptable
- Current resume or CV demonstrating intern or volunteer time to an organization that supports underserved populations
- Current resume or CV documenting language(s) other than English that are spoken fluently
- One-page essay describing your language skills and commitment to underserved populations, and how these experiences will help you in your future career as a pharmacist. The essay must be single-spaced, Time New Roman font size 12, 1" margins.
