### One award of \$1000

This award recognizes an advanced pharmacy student with strong scholastic achievement and financial need.

#### Eligibility criteria

- Student in the last three years of Pharm.D. program
- High scholastic standing (minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale)
- Demonstrated financial need to help with tuition, books, etc. (Note: Students who have received a “full scholarship” that covers all expenses will not be awarded this scholarship)

#### Review criteria

- Scholastic achievement
- Ability to lead others
- Strong desire to enter community practice upon graduation and has current or previous experience in community practice

#### Submit for review

- Current resume or CV demonstrating a history of community service related to retail pharmacy
- Documentation of a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (Unofficial transcript from the TCWeb is acceptable)
- One-page essay describing your most meaningful community service experience related to retail pharmacy and how this experience will help you in the future as a pharmacist. The essay must be single-spaced, Time New Roman font size 12, 1" margins.
